Academic Year (2014-15)

In this academic year, the institute entered into Silver Jubilee Year (25th year) of its establishment. The institute continued to follow its tradition of providing quality education to the aspirants in this year also.

All currently running courses namely B. Pharm, M. Pharm, and B. Sc. (Biotech) successfully accomplished the set goals in this academic year. This year, in B. Pharm, overall passing percentage was above 70% . M. Pharm. students recorded passing percentage of 72 % and for B. Sc. Biotech it was 100 %.

Our two B.Pharm. Final Year students qualified national level competitive examination GPAT (Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test). Four campus drives were conducted for the placement (Apollo Hospitals, Nutri Synapzz, GST Corporations and Abott India Ltd.) of B. Pharm (Final Year) students. Through these campus drives, 20 students got placed.

The institute has got another well furnished class-room for B.Pharm. students. The highlight of the infrastructural development in the institute is the establishment of new laboratory for the proposed M.Sc. (Biotechnology) course.

Institute conducted few guest lectures by eminent subject experts on various relevant topics of pharmaceutical field.

As a routine procedure, inspections by the regulating bodies were conducted. Inspections by AICTE and PCI were successfully completed for conduction of M. Pharm and B. Pharm courses respectively.
